The Diocese of Cheyenne has been notified that Rev. Daniel J. Kenney, SJ of the Jesuits Midwest Providence, was laicized November 2, 2020, after multiple allegations of abuse occurring while assigned to Creighton Preparatory School in Omaha, NE, between the years of 1980 and 1987. The allegations of abuse did not take place within the Diocese of Cheyenne; however, in the 1970s, Fr Kenney (also known as the Monkey Priest) was founder of Camp Buford, a summer camp for disadvantaged middle school students located on donated land near the Grand Tetons of Wyoming. If you or anyone you know has suffered from sexual abuse as a minor, please contact the local law enforcement agency or the Department of Family Services.
